## What is MELCS

The Mable Early Language and Communication Screener (MELCS) is a research-driven digital tool designed to quickly identify children aged 4-5 (Reception year) at risk of Speech, Language, and Communication Needs (SLCN). With easy-to-administer subtests, MELCS provides reliable results, enabling schools to offer timely intervention and support for students in need.



## Why MELCS?

Early detection of SLCN is critical in preventing long term academic and social difficulties. By using MELCS, your school can:

- **Identify at-risk students early** to ensure they receive the support they need.
- **Guide targeted interventions**, avoiding learning delays and helping children reach their potential.
- **Support inclusive education** by recognizing the individual needs of students.

## How does it work?

MELCS assesses a child's communication skills through several subtests, including **Non-Word Repetition** to evaluate phonological memory and vocabulary, **Sentence Repetition** for verbal memory and grammar, and **Grammar Comprehension** to assess sentence structure understanding. It also analyses **Expressive Verb Morphology** for correct verb usage and **Sound Production** to identify speech sound disorders through verbal responses to images.
